Scholarship Programme (CZ07) Measures to achieve the goals

Mobility projects and placements

"Increased student and staff mobility between Beneficiary and EEA EFTA States" – indicators:

- ECTS mobility;
- joint supervision / presentation of PhD work;
- increased skills / competencies of staff;
- new HE mobility agreements;
- promotional events.

Institutional cooperation projects

"Increased and strengthened institutional cooperation at all levels of the education sector between Beneficiary and EEA EFTA States" – indicators:

- production of joint products and services (scientific publication, common curricula, joint teaching methodologies, joint summer schools/intensive courses, presentations of papers at international conferences, good practice handbooks and guidelines, management and development plans, where environmental and sustainability issues are integrated);
- further cooperation (planned or realised);
- promotional events.


- 4 Calls = 4 chances for support (Calls within EEA Grants)












Overview of Institutional cooperation projects (ICP) -Norway Grants_Home institutions_2014A,2014B,2015








