- we develop new tools to support closer cooperation between the academic and the business sector



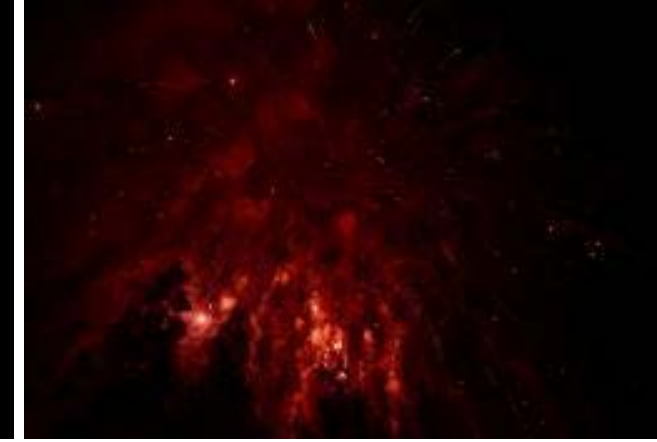
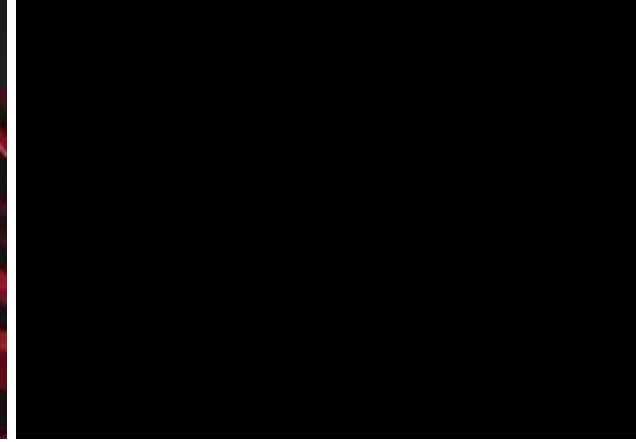
TA CR IN NUMBERS

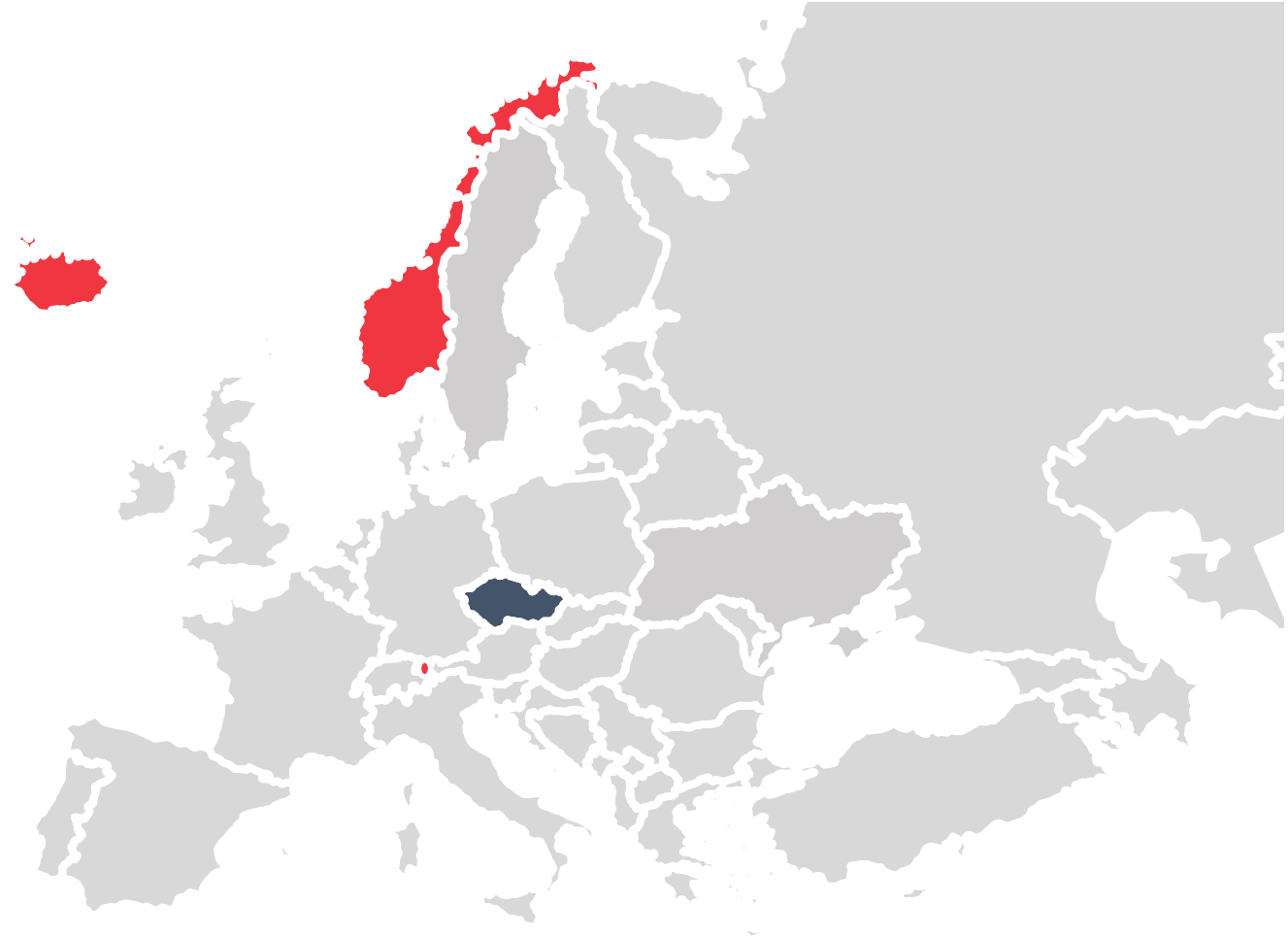

The Programme is implemented within the both EEA and Norwegian financial mechanisms (EEA and Norway Grants).

The project shall always host a minimum of one participant from the **Czech Republic** and one from **Norway, Iceland or Liechtenstein** while the applicant shall be from the Czech Republic.

The preferred model is the participation of an enterprise in cooperation with a research organisation.

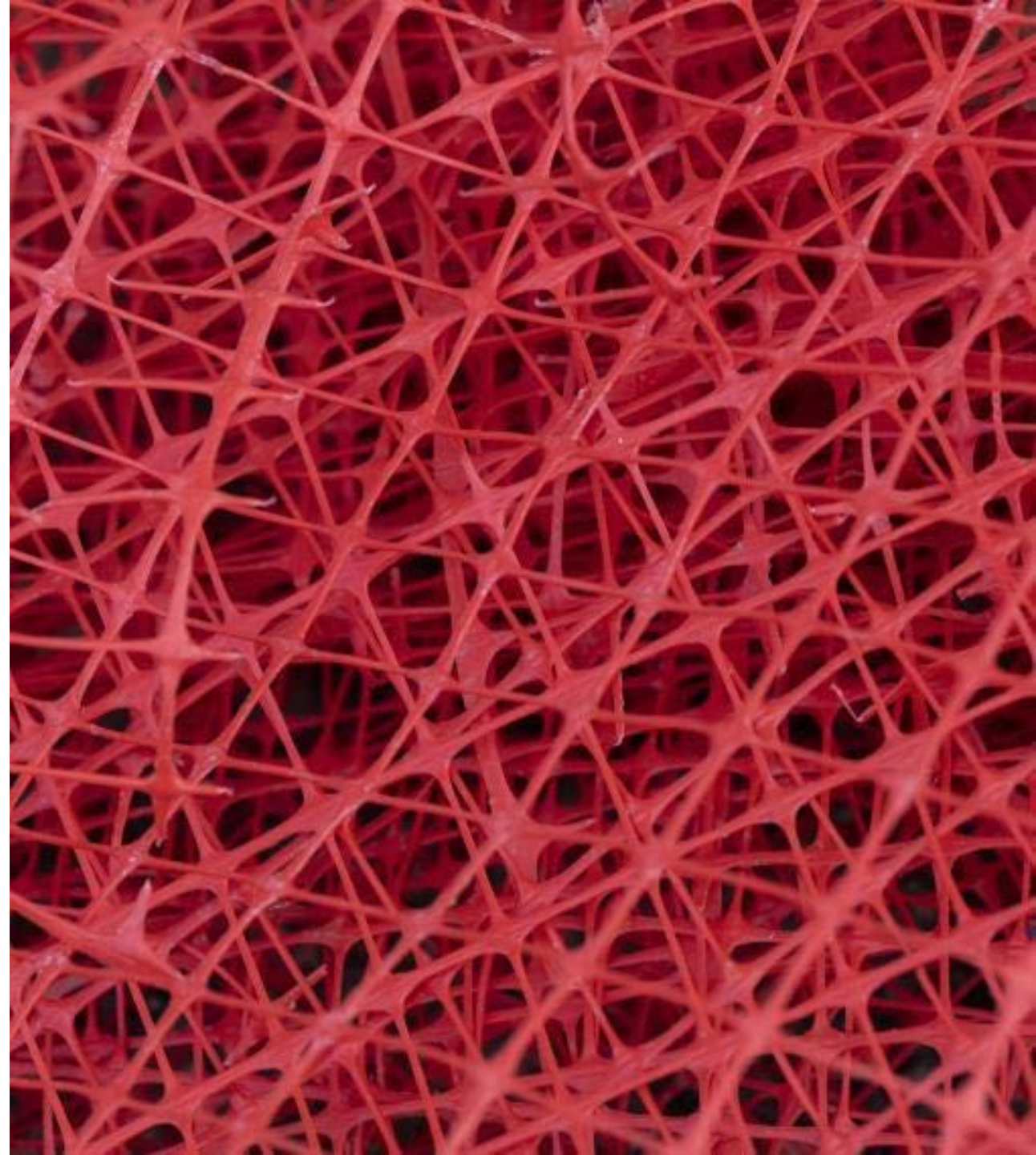

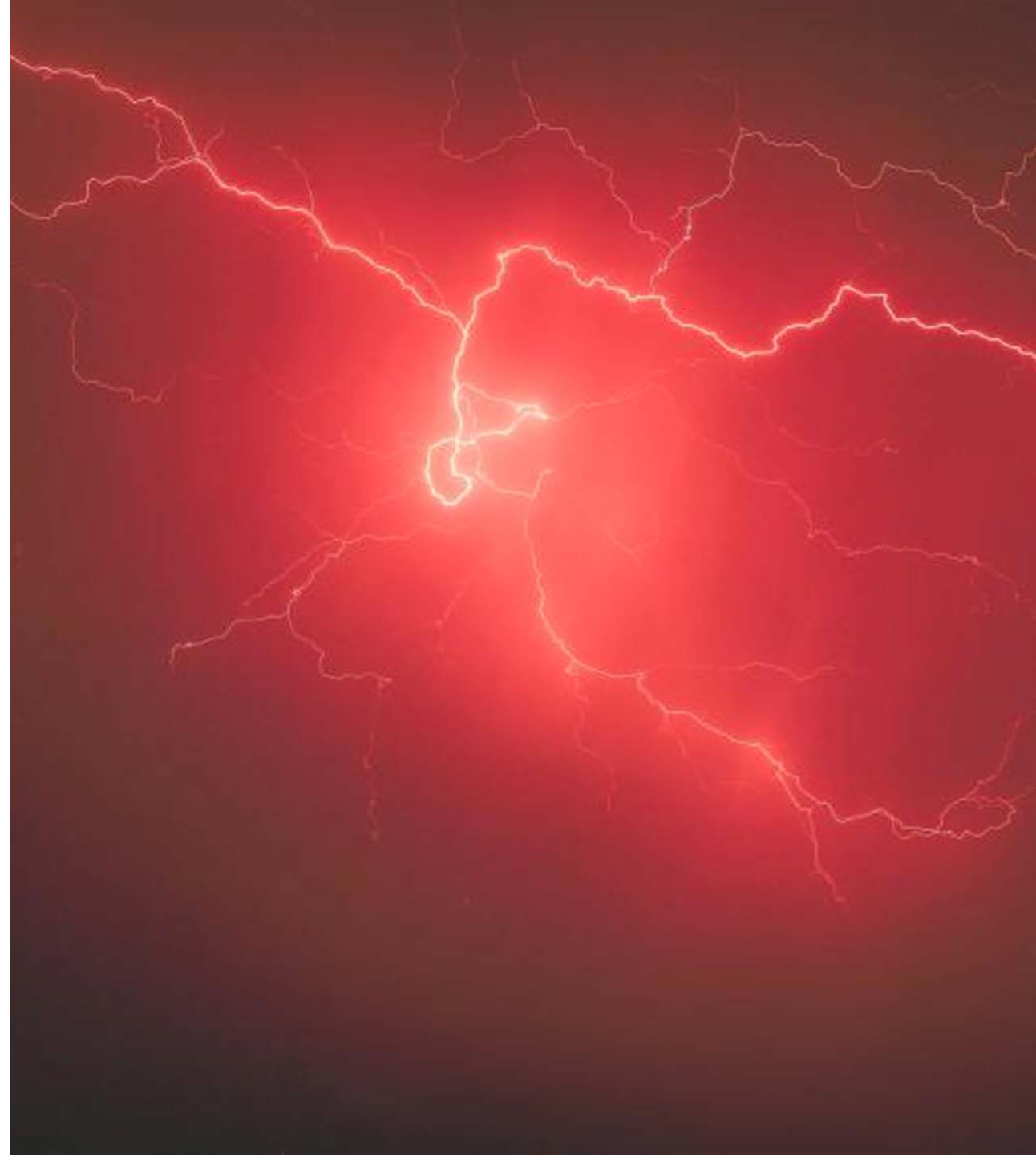
